## Kingsley Pines - The Way Camp Should Be

The State of Maine has a law that affects all campers who are medically required to carry at all times and to self-administer emergency medication while at camp. These are campers who have been diagnosed to be at risk for a potential medical crisis, such as an asthma attack or an allergic reaction. The medications include an asthma inhaler or an EpiPen.

If you want your child to be able to carry and self-administer these medications, we need written permission from both your child's licensed medical personnel and you, to comply with this law.
