




Cabin Assignments

Kingsley Pines has two campuses on opposite sides of camp, Mountainside for boys and Lakeside for girls. If you want to discuss which side of camp is right for your child, please get in touch with us. Campers are assigned to cabins based on several factors. Primarily, campers are assigned by school grade. Some cabins may include multiple school grades, based on enrollment numbers. We make every effort to keep no more than two grades in a single cabin. Campers and families learn about their cabin assignments on opening day.



Camper Requests

Your child may request to be in the same cabin with a friend if they are in the same grade, or one grade apart. We only guarantee to meet one request per camper if the request is submitted on the **cabinmate request form** by both families and the campers are in the same grade. You may make more than one request, but in the best interest of cabin dynamics, we cannot guarantee more than one. We cannot have 8th- and 9th-graders in the same cabin because younger and older campers live in different sections of the campus.

OLDER CAMPER NOTE: cabins for older campers (9th, 10th, and 11th grade) typically sleep three campers and a counselor. The small cabins are then grouped into cabin groups of two or three small cabins. **All older camper cabinmate requests are considered met if the campers are in the same cabin group.** This cabin group functions as a single cabin for all camp programming.

Balance and Dynamics

In building our cabin assignments, we attempt to balance the number of new and returning campers in each cabin. Similarly, we are mindful of avoiding too many campers from a single region or community. Camp is a great place to make new friends and meet new people. As we develop relationships with campers, either over the years of knowing them or during the registration process, we learn a little about their personalities and who they are. We strive to foster cabin dynamics that enable positive social connections to form! The more honest information you share on the Camper Information Form, the better we can create the best cabin for your camper!
